OUR VISION: We envision a community where those we serve achieve and sustain financial stability

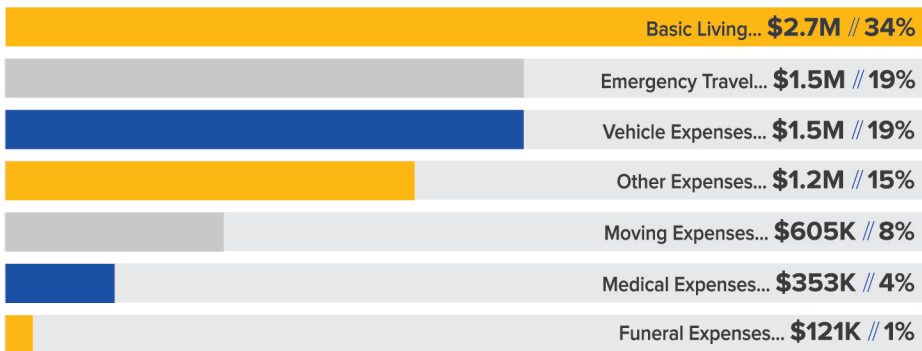

- **Gen Henry H. Arnold Education Grants = \$2.6M**
- **1,707** grants ranging from **\$500 to \$4,000** for dependent children & spouses
- **Merit Scholarships = \$80,000**
- **16** dependent scholars earned scholarships
- **Supplemental Education Loans = \$46,000**
- **42** families received no interest loans to help pay for incidental college expenses
